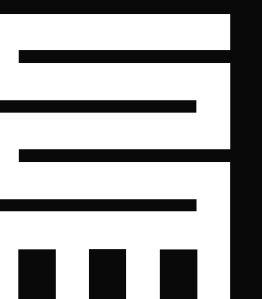


CULTURAL WEB CONFERENCE

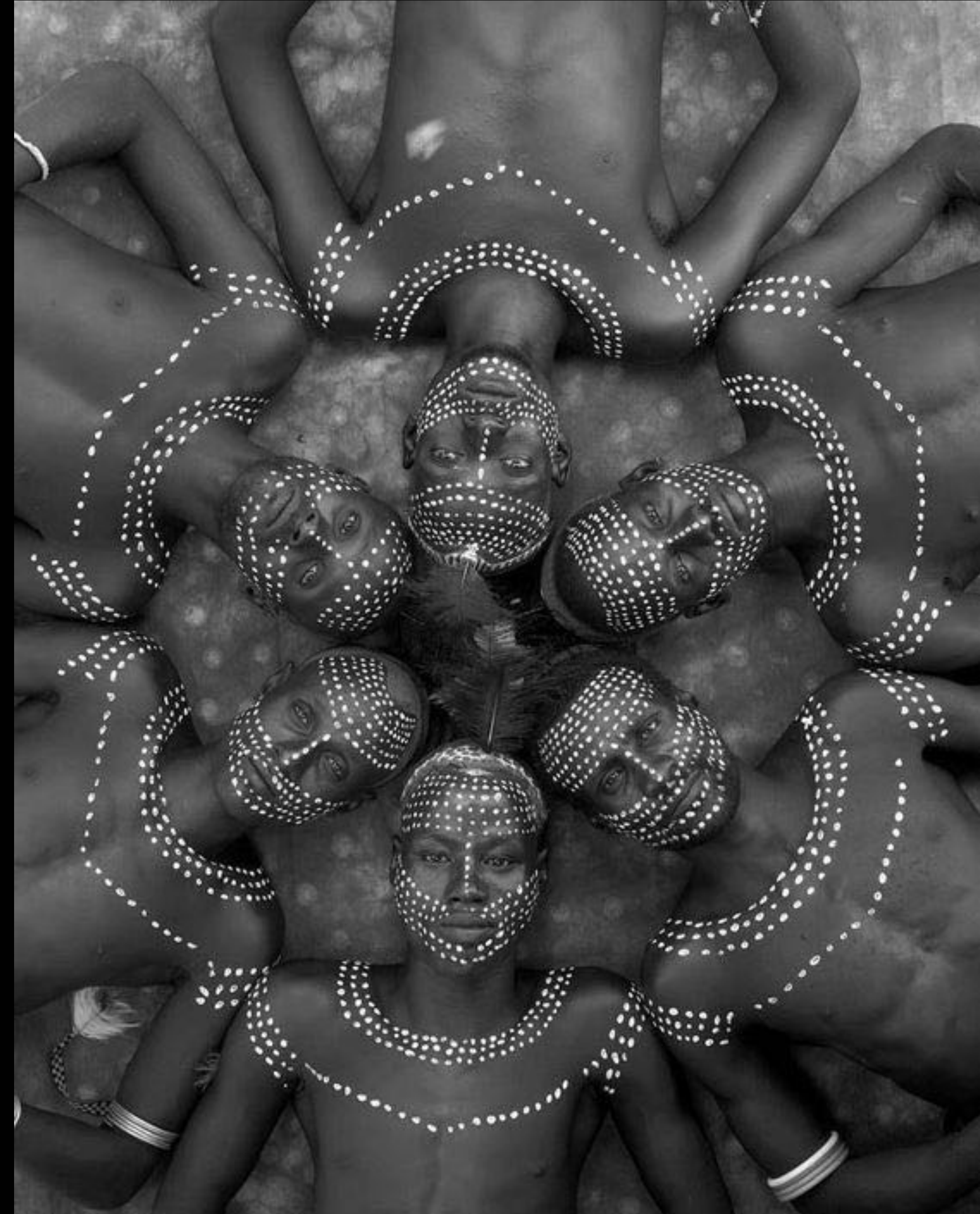
